Northern Virginia Alliance League (NVAL), a 501(c)(3) non-profit, is a women's organization focused on improving the lives of those in need and the communities in which they live. This is accomplished by supporting charitable organizations through fundraising and volunteer efforts.

The group was originally formed in 1957 as a circle of the Florence Crittenton Home and Hospital. In 1982, the circle members decided to redirect their efforts to assist Northern Virginia charities, and the Northern Virginia Assistance League was established. Each year, NVAL members choose a non-profit organization to receive the funds raised through two annual events. The organizations are vetted by our Community Support committee and voted on by the membership. Since 1983, NVAL has distributed over \$850,000 to our community.

Our 55th annual Holiday Luncheon will be held on Tuesday, December 5th at Washington Golf and Country Club, and all profits from the event will be donated to the Virginia McCaffrey Fund for Children at Doorways. This fundraiser continues to be successful year after year in large part because of the tremendous support of our local business partners.
